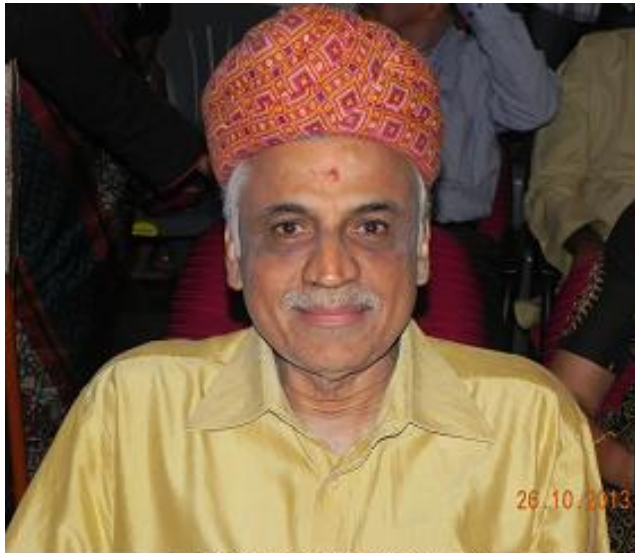
Fellowship on 26th October
